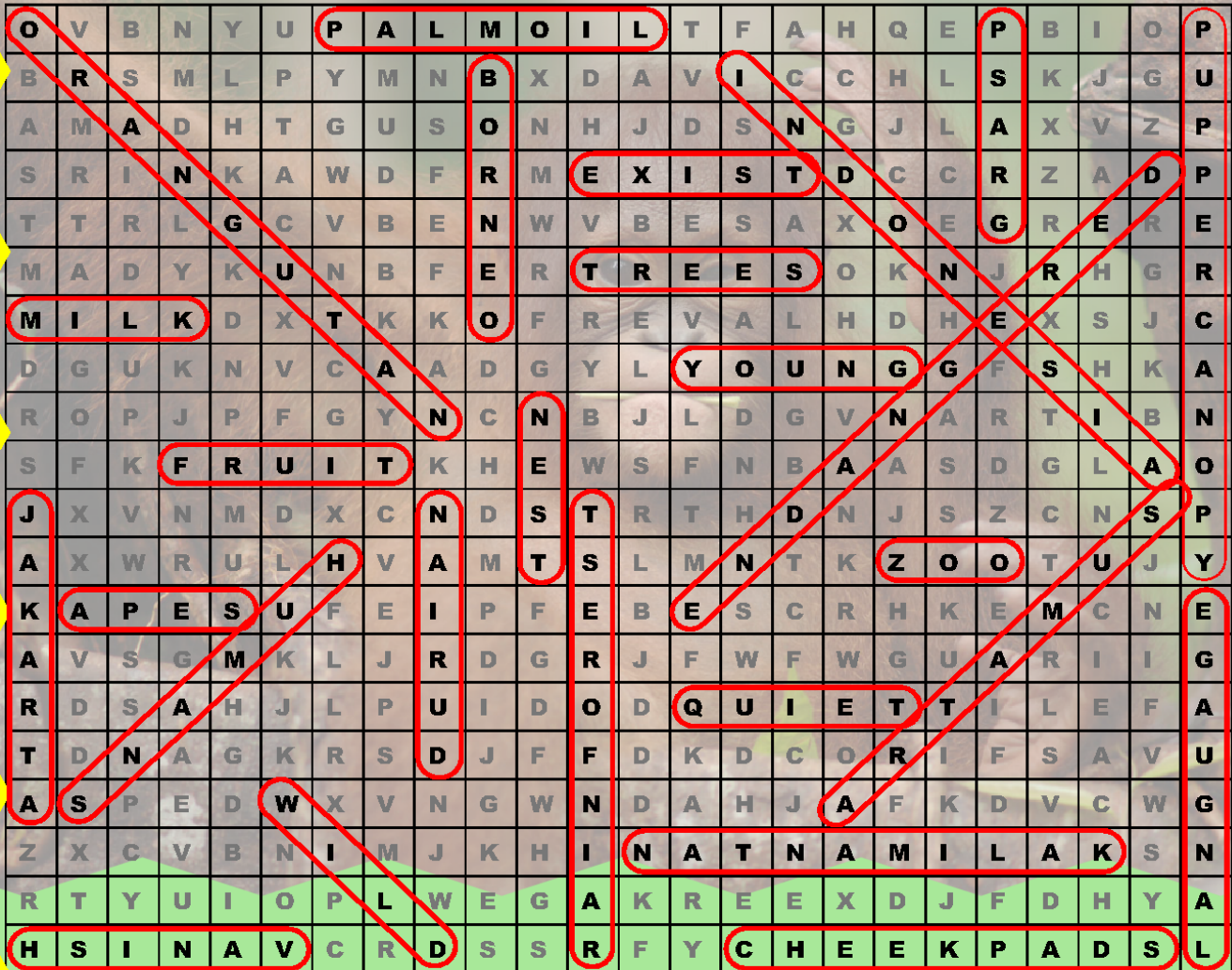


Orangutan Outreach: Orangutans from A to Z



Along with chimpanzees, gorillas and bonobos, orangutans are Great APES.

One of the islands that orangutans can be found on is BORNEO.

Male orangutans grow large CHEEK PADS on their face as they get older.

DURIAN is a large fruit with a spiky husk and a custard-like flesh with an unusual odor.

Orangutans are an ENDANGERED species.

Orangutans love to eat FRUIT.

Orangutans GRASP things with their hands and feet.

Orangutans are very similar to HUMANS.

Most orangutans can be found in INDONESIA.

JAKARTA is the capital of Indonesia.

The Indonesian name for Borneo is KALIMANTAN.

The 'Orangutan LANGUAGE Project' teaches orangutans at the National Zoo to "talk" using a computer monitor with large buttons and pictures on the screen.

Orangutans love to drink MILK.

Orangutans build a new NEST every night for sleeping in.

ORANGUTAN means "person of the forest".

The biggest threat to orangutans is PALM OIL.

Orangutans are so QUIET that you may not know they are in the trees above you.

Orangutans live in the RAINFOREST.

Besides Borneo, wild orangutans are only found on the island of SUMATRA.

Orangutans like to swing in the TREES.

Orangutan spend most of their time in the UPPER CANOPY of the forest.

If we don't act now, orangutans will VANISH from the wild.

Orangutans should only live in the WILD and not be kept as pets.

Orangutans have the right to EXIST, just like humans.

YOUNG orangutans usually stay with their mothers until they are about 8 years old.
